



## **Redeemable Containers for Traip Academy Student Scholarships**

The Department of Public Works is collecting redeemable containers with the proceeds going towards scholarships for Traip Academy Students planning to attend a 4yr, 2yr. or vocational/trade school.

**Only containers purchased in the State of Maine can be used for this donation (as you have already paid the returnable deposit amount).**

Any containers purchased in the State of New Hampshire must be placed in the appropriate, marked containers located on the outside of the recyclable windows. Large barrels are marked for your convenience at the plastics, metals, and glass areas. We will recycle these containers, but not redeem them.

KSWF is partnering with CLYNK to process the containers and bags/tags are available for your use at home. Please see the KSWF Attendant if you would like to bag your own containers at home and then bring them back to the KSWF or directly to Hannaford CLYNK station.
