the disclosure of who pays for  
political ads, and to increase  
penalties for violations of  
campaign finance law?**

**2. Bond Issue**

**Do you favor a \$15,000,000 bond  
issue for the construction of new  
energy-efficient affordable homes  
for low-income seniors, the  
adaptive reuse of structures for  
homes for low-income seniors  
and the repair and weatherization  
of existing homes for low-income  
seniors, which will create jobs  
and will be matched by an  
estimated \$22,600,000 in private  
and other funds?**

Total estimated life time cost is  
\$19,125,000 representing \$15,000,000  
in principal and \$4,125,000 in interest  
(assuming interest at 5.0% over 10  
years).

**Do you favor an \$85,000,000 bond  
issue for construction,  
reconstruction and rehabilitation  
of highways and bridges and for  
facilities and equipment related  
to ports, harbors, marine  
transportation, freight and  
passenger railroads, aviation,

pedestrian trails, to be used to  
match an estimated \$121,500,000  
in federal and other funds?**

\$23,375,000 in interest (assuming
