Subject: SAFETY ZONES

Bion:

These are the proposed safety zones that we are planning to apply from 9-12 June. We are still working out the details but we will likely be applying the zones between 0800-1700 daily. Please feel free to share with your customers, particularly fishermen.

The red boxes are fixed safety zones.

The small white circle is simply meant to represent a 100 yard moving safety zone that will encompass various Navy and Coast Guard craft up and down the river. There could be as many as five such 100 yard mobile zones at one time.

Access to the red boxes and white circle (mobile) will be prohibited unless authorized by the Coast Guard. However, we plan to work with vessel operators to transit the river. Due to the diving in the red boxes, we will probably be less inclined to allow access during the periods of operation.

The yellow is an artificial channel employed for exercise purposes only. We understand that as one travels up the river it becomes a real channel.
