1. ROLL CALL

Roll call noted.

2. PRESENTATION BY CHRISTIE RABASCA AND CHRISTINE RHINEHART - NONSTORMWATER ORDINANCE

Ms. Rabasca makes the presentation. The nonstormwater ordinance is designed to prohibit people from dumping things down the storm drain system that they should not dump there, such as oil, pet waste, etc. It only applies to the separate storm drain system, including ditches. One common unlawful discharge in a rural area is wash water. This is a federal ordinance. There is a list of the allowed nonstormwater discharges - what can go into the system. Kittery is one of few communities (28) within Maine that is subject to this requirement. It deals primarily with urbanized areas. Kittery can determine whether it wants it to apply the ordinance outside of the urban area. Most towns are going town-wide. South Berwick is the only one she has seen so far that is only doing the urbanized area. There is a significant federal fine for not complying with the ordinance. This is one component of a five year plan that was developed. Rick Rossiter and the Spruce Creek Association had some input into this. Rick Rossiter and the Town employees will go through training on this. Jim Katzifikis drafted the ordinance. It's a stand-alone ordinance, like Shoreland Zoning, and Kittery needs to have implemented it by June 2006.
