- \*Affordable Housing ordinance includes fund for addressing potentially energy saving retrofits, EV stations, etc. in affordable housing. Explore an energy savings fund for retrofits that don't fall within the affordable housing ordinance but meet low-income criteria.
- \*\*EVs smaller so fewer parking spaces needed with some dedicated for EVs; incentivize for multifamily homes, inns, motels; keep out of high traffic/congestion areas but locate in destinations with amenities for people visiting from away
