Updates from last meeting

Stephen reports that there is funding from the state available to create a bicycle lane which entails marking the road but not expanding Route 103

Erin researched CMP and found that they are “decoupled” as of 2008 This means that they deliver energy BUT donot generate it They appear to be indifferent in saving Kw and selling Kw, but they are looking for new sources of revenue. (Despite being owned by a Spanish company, they are regulated the same as other energy companies.)

They have offered the town of York LED replacement street lights but appear to not have fully formulated their offer and plan.

Dave (per Julia) is in process of contacting Mitchell School Green Team to find out their goals so that we can be on board to assist in fall 2018 school year.

Julia has spoken to Rozanna Patane chair of the York Energy Committe and they are interested in collaborating with KESAC to create informative sessions for the general public. (Eliot Energy Committe will be included also)

Jerry has updated KESAC info and has submitted to the town managers secretary who will review and post on the town's website.

A lively discussion about solar municipal Power Purchase Agreement ensued. It was agreed that we need to get more info about the town's position before pursuing this further. Julia will follow up with Kendra.

updated status of the LED project . At the April 9 town council meeting Kendra stated that Chief O'Brien had written an RFP.

Meeting for May TBD dependent on work needed to be done.
