Jon, here is the proposed Amendment to the Seapoint and Crescent Beaches Ordinance. It is very short and simple and it only changes that portion providing for parking by both residents and nonresidents. I assume the appropriate signage would be erected in the spaces where resident and nonresident parking would be allowed and I further assume it would be up to five parking spaces. I have also added to the end of this proposed Ordinance some language that has been carried by ORC in previous Ordinances relating the dates of adoption.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 12.4, SEAPOINT AND
CRESCENT BEACHES, VEHICULAR USE--PARKING
RESTRICTIONS, SECTION 12.4.3 B and C (2)**

The Town of Kittery hereby ordains the following amendments to Chapter 12.4, Section 12.4.3 B and C (2) Vehicular use--Parking restrictions:

*Note: New language is shown as underlined text.
Deleted language is shown by strikeout type.*

SECTION 12.4.3, Parking restrictions B and C (2) are amended as follows:

- B. ~~Use of the beaches and p~~arking in all designated parking areas for Seapoint and Crescent beaches are is available for town residents and nonresidents from October 1st to May 14th only. Nonresident parking in designated parking areas for ~~the~~ Seapoint and Crescent beaches from May 15th to September 30th, inclusive, is prohibited except in the parking area designated by signage for both resident and nonresident parking.

This restriction does not apply to vehicles enumerated in Sections 12.20.010(A) and (B) of Chapter 12.20 and Section 12.12.150(A).

- C. Parking is allowed on the south side of Seapoint Road from its intersection with Thaxter Road a distance of five hundred fifty (550) feet in a westerly direction, subject

to the following restrictions:

1. All vehicles must be parked off the paved roadway surface;
2. May 15th to September 30th, inclusive, all parking is limited to vehicles bearing valid Kittery solid waste stickers or guest permits issued by the Kittery police department except for parking in the area designated by signage for both resident and nonresident parking;
3. October 1st to May 14th, inclusive, parking is allowed without stickers.
