Mandatory Separation of recycling and resource recovery materials is in effect for all users of the Kittery Solid Waste Facility. Violations of the ordinance are enforceable as defined in Title 8. All users must have a current Kittery Permit Decal or Commercial Haulers License at all times. Decals shall be affixed no higher than 4" from the bottom line of the driver's side windshield or door window. Licenses shall be presented to the Attendant prior to each tipping.

Resource items are described in the Resource Recovery Facility Fee Schedule, updated on July 1, 2010, with the appropriate fee for each item. The fees reflect the cost of disposing of each item and are in line with the fees charged by our neighboring towns. The Resource side of our business is only open on Wednesday and Saturday and is operated by an attendant in Building C at all times.

Recyclable items are separated by the resident and disposed of into the appropriate container/area in each different window: (1) Plastics # 1 PET & #2HDPE only: *soft drinks, water, juice, milk, detergent* (2) Paper Mixed: *dry food boxes, magazines, junk mail, etc.* & Newsprint: *newspaper, inserts, phonebooks,* (3) Corrugated Cardboard: *boxes, pizza boxes, shiny allowed,* (4) Cans: *tin, aluminum, steel,* (5) Glass: *bottles, jars.* Solid Waste (trash) disposal is also in this same Building A. All trash should be in bags and free of any recyclable or resource materials. The Solid Waste and Recycling side of our business is open Tuesdays through Saturday.

Voluntary Separation of redeemable or reusable items assists in minimizing the costs of disposal therefore benefiting all the taxpayers of Kittery by lowering the operating costs of the KSWF.

Redeemable items are being collected on a voluntary basis. Only returnable containers purchased in the State of Maine can be accepted at the KSWF. All proceeds are given as scholarships to Kittery residents and are managed by the Kittery Recycling Scholarship Committee.

Reuse items may be brought to the Freebie Barn during their operating hours only. Items should be clean and in good condition. All items are free to any resident of Kittery.
