SCENIC VIEW/VISTA

To qualify as a scenic view/vista, designated scenic sites shall contain one or more of the following elements:

- 1. A view over land towards the ocean or a tidal inlet or bay which is unobstructed by any manmade structure or natural feature:
- 2. A view over land or water towards a hill, mountain, open land or other natural feature which is relatively uncluttered and attractive to the eye of a person with a reasonable appreciation for scenic views;
- 3. A view over land and/or water, which shall include manmade structures usually associated with rural communities, such as church steeples, open fields, barns and domestic animals.
- 4. A visual scene over land and/or water, which includes traditional elements of a maritime community. Such elements may include boats, piers, buoys, lighthouses and other elements commonly found within coastal communities.
