

# FAQ's for Snow Plowing and Removal

Q: My road has not been plowed, can I get it plowed now?
A:The Highway Department follows an assigned route plan which includes your road...please be patient $\odot$

Q: My sidewalk has not been plowed, when will it get done?
A: The Highway Department follows an assigned route plan for sidewalk snow plowing and removal that begins the day after the storm. Generally it takes 3-4 days after the storm to clear the sidewalks from a single storm.
Reminder: Depositing driveway snow over a town sidewalk or in the right of way is illegal - Fines start at $\$ 150.00$.

Q: Can you remove the snow piles at the ends of my driveway?
A: For removal of snow buildup, residents need to contract with a private snow removal company.

One resource is www.servicemagic.com, input your topic, snow, and your zip code and a few other short questions, and a provider will call you.
www.magicyellow.com, input the topic, snow removal, and your zip code and a list of contractors will be created.

Reminder: It is not only illegal, but can be a serious traffic hazard to shovel or plow snow into or across the roadway.
Fines start at $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0 . 0 0}$. If you have a private contractor plowing your driveway please make sure to remind them of this as you will be held responsible for their actions
