(Pills, Liquids, Capsules)

The University of Maine Center on Aging has a program called "Safe Medicine Disposal for Maine" available for all Maine residents. The program is to help dispose of unused and expired medicines, free and anonymously. Free mail in bags are available at licensed sites throughout Maine. This program is <u>not</u> intended for disposal of needles. York Hospital is our closest site for needle disposal and other medical waste.
