Multi-family housing doesn't always look the same. Some multi-family structures are condos, while others are rental units. Some are occupied by multiple generations of a single family, while others are simply neighbors.

Some homes may appear unmistakably multi-family, while other homes look like a single-family home from the exterior.

Multi-family housing is commonly more affordable than single-family housing and is a more efficient use of land and building infrastructure.

Multi-family housing serves a wider range of household types and sizes, and their various needs and economic means.
