

Average Score =

- Some bare spots on field, many dips/heaves in field are a tripping hazard and some do not properly drain, dips appear to pond at times.
- 2. Football goal posts, practice equipment, and benches appear to be old and rust can be seen on all of them.
- 3. Fence between building/grandstands and football field is a low spot that has significant ponding issues. Fence also in fair condition
- 4. Section of field is located in baseball infield which is raised and is another tripping hazard.

### Stakeholder Questionnaire Response Highlights

- Current fields are at or exceed capacity, field conditions are suffering because of overuse.
- Many fields are shared across multiple programs, complicating scheduling.
- Stakeholders expressed a want for a central location for all or most of high school sports to be played.
- Stakeholders expressed support for synthetic turf fields.
- Stakeholders expressed support for lighting of fields to add playable time.
- High level of effort and cost of maintenance currently required.
- The need for improved and expanded parking at Memorial Field.




### **Identified Deficiencies**


Priority needs stressed by the various stakeholders included the following:

- Athletic lighting and turf.
- Provide additional amenities at Memorial Field (i.e., locker rooms, storage, bullpens/batting cages, playground, concessions)
- Improved and expanded parking at Memorial Field.
- Provide a state-of-the-art athletic facility that provides equal opportunities for all high school and youth sports to use.
- Provide improvements to all fields at Memorial Field, as the current fields are in poor condition.
- Accommodate field—use demand and address deficiencies identified.

### **Design Constraints**

- Maintain existing electrical/utilities building in the southwestern corner of the site.
- No proposed synthetic turf field along Legion Pond due to required environmental buffer zones.
- Inclusion of a Fire Lane that provides access via State Route 1 and Old Post Road.
- Minimize the overlap of field lines between the multi-purpose rectangular field and the 90' diamond baseball field.

- Obtained Information from Fields Committee
- Questionnaire issued to both Town and School Maintenance Staff
- Potential Future Maintenance Direction-Recommended Maintenance Tasks, Budget and Draft Inclement Weather Policy






