Action: review for completeness, continue approve accept or deny: Pursuant to §16.4 Land Use Regulations and §16.9.3 Shoreland Development Review requirements of the Town of Kittery Land Use and Development Code, owner B.I.W. Group, LLC and agent Steven Riker with Ambit Engineering request approval to expand a legally non-conforming building and convert an existing office building to 10 residential units on a legally conforming lot located on real property with the address of 35 Badgers Island West, Tax Map 44, Lot 71, in the Mixed-Use Badgers Island Zone (MU-BI), Shoreland Overlay Zone (OZ-SL-250'), and Resource Protection Overlay Zone (OZ-RP).

- 49 and/or osa rugosa, as well as erosion-resistant ground cover plantings must be retained and planted,
- and existing trees retained, wherever practicable in the setback;
- 51 [3] Implementation of a stormwater management plan endorsed by the York County Soil and Water
- 52 Conservation District (SCS), or the Town's engineering peer review consultant, that treats stormwater
- 53 with appropriate BMPs and removes pollutants in accordance with the most-current edition of the
- 54 Maine Department of Environmental Protection BMP Manual, Stormwater Management for Maine.
- Pollutants sought to be removed include suspended solids, nitrates, hydrocarbons and heavy metals.
- 56 Such special treatment of the first flush of runoff may include detention, infiltration, filtering and
- 57 trapping of pollutants.
