Old Post Road small area planning 30 31 The EDC continued discussion on the intersection of Old Post Road and Dennett Road and 32 what improvements, if any, would improve the viability of the neighborhood. Adam Causey 33 presented maps of the area and identified subject parcels that could be included in the 34 analysis. George Dow indicated there should be a shared vision for the corner. Jeff Clifford 35 said the land use should include neighborhood commercial and the plan should identify transportation improvements or concerns. Drew Fitch stated that some retail services could 36 37 be allowed but nothing too intense, and also noted that the split-zoned parcels should be 38 rezoned, given the Legion Pond setbacks would limit the development on the eastern side of 39 the corner. Bart McDonough indicated this corner should be "people-focused" and the 40 committee could investigate having no parking minimums, assuming on-street or other 41 parking options are provided. Stephen Kosacz stated that affordable housing could be a use 42 developed here. Jeff Clifford noted that there could be room for ancillary uses near the pond, 43 such as a warming hut. Adam Causev said that staff would return at the next meeting with 44 language on a vision for this area, an analysis on the current zoning, and the next steps for 45 public outreach. 46 47 8.
