
2018 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT



Dennett Road Bridge, Kittery



Project Highlights

- \$890,000 project part of \$1.3 million contract
- Contract awarded to CPM Constructors of Freeport, ME
- Project anticipated to start in March 2018
- New pavement surface on the northbound bridge
- Upgrading bridge median guardrail to concrete barrier
- Bridge joint, bearing & girder repairs
- Closures of Exit 1 in both directions will be required (see reverse side for more information)
- Projected to be complete by August 31, 2018

This project consists of general repairs and modifications to the Dennett Road Overpass Bridge in Kittery. The scope of the work includes a new pavement surface on the northbound bridge, joint repairs, bearing repairs, reconstruction of the concrete end post, upgrades to the guardrail connections, upgrades to the bridge median guardrail to concrete barrier, abutment repairs, girder repairs and concrete deck repairs.

The \$890,000 project is part of a \$1.3 million contract awarded to CPM Constructors of Freeport. Work on this project is expected to begin in March 2018 and scheduled to be complete by August 31, 2018.

In order to maintain three lanes of traffic in each direction on the mainline of the Turnpike, closures of Exit 1 northbound and southbound will be required. VMS boards and detour signs will be in place during the closures. Work on the Turnpike mainline is scheduled to be complete by June 22, 2018.

Exit 1 Northbound Detour

The Exit 1 northbound ramp will be closed for the duration of the work on the in order to maintain three lanes of traffic on the mainline of the Turnpike.

Exit 1 Southbound Detour



The Exit 1 southbound ramp will be closed for 28 days to in order to maintain three lanes of traffic on the mainline of the Turnpike.
