**This permit allows the Permit holder to have one campfire on Seapoint Beach for the purpose of warming or cooking only.**

- Campfires are prohibited on the north side of Seapoint Beach.
- Bonfires are prohibited.
- Permit holder must be at least 18 years old.
- Permit is valid for the date indicated ONLY.
- The Permit holder is responsible to ensure the campfire extinguished completely (no active embers) by 11PM.
- All trash, waste, and litter must be removed from the site.
- Permit is non-transferable. The Permit holder must be present at all times when the campfire is burning and is responsible for extinguishing the fire and removing all waste from the site.
- The burning of plastics, petroleum-based products, Styrofoam, metals, food wastes, chemicals, treated wood, furniture, pallets or other solid wastes is prohibited.
- The Permit holder must check the State of Maine Forest Service Wildfire Danger Report to determine "Class Day" prior to starting the campfire. Fires are prohibited on days with a High, Very High, or Extreme fire danger Class Day.
- The Permit holder is responsible for any resulting costs associated with fire response and/or damage to public and private property if the fire escapes due to negligence or if the fire is created on a prohibited Class Day.
