TRAILS

Kittery Town Forest 

98 Haley Rd | Kittery, ME

72 acres that runs from Haley Road nearly through to Lewis Road in a South-North direction.

Rogers Park Conservation Area 

46-68 Dion Ave | Kittery, ME

27 acres along Spruce Creek with a beautiful view of the water. Donated by Richard Rogers in 1958.

Norton Preserve 

150 Norton Rd | Kittery, ME

208 acres on the Kittery/York town line. Located on a dead-end road in a residential neighborhood, parking can be found after the mailbox at the intersection with Woods Road.

Remick Preserve 

35-19 Fernald Rd | Kittery, ME

Over 70 acres of recently improved trails. Look out for the yellow fire hydrant and stairs marking the start of the trailhead.

Brave Boat Headwaters 

185 Brave Boat Harbor Rd | Kittery Point, ME

The newest addition to Kittery Land Trust, this spot is 100 acres and located right off of route 103.

Cutts Island Trail on the Rachel 

Carson Nature Preserve

37 Seapoint Rd | Kittery Point, ME

This Preserve boasts 7600 acres and 1.8 miles from Kittery to Cape Elizabeth.

Seapoint and Crescent Beaches 

11 Seapoint Rd | Kittery, ME

Short walking trails located on the point at the end of Seapoint Beach.

Fisherman's Walk (York) 

121 Clark's Ln, | York, ME

A beautiful 2 mile walk along the coast with a stop at the famed Wiggly Bridge.
