To: Guidance Counselors & Scholarship Candidates

Once again, the Kittery Recycling Scholarship Selection Committee is pleased to offer an annual scholarship funded by the generous donations of redeemable containers from Kittery residents at the Kittery Resource Recovery Facility. Processing is coordinated through Public Works employees using the CLYNK program. Applications are reviewed and selections are made by the Kittery Educational Scholarship Selection Committee.

Any resident of the town who will graduate, or has graduated, from an accredited high school, G.E.D. program or a home-schooling program, and who intends to enroll in a post-secondary college, university, vocational-technical, or other educational program is eligible to apply. In addition to academic achievement, financial need, and leadership, special consideration may be given to any applicant who demonstrates a direct connection to environmental studies.

First time applicants will be required to write an essay of 250-500 words answering, "Why is it important to protect the environment and what actions do you take in your daily life to reduce your environmental impact?" Acceptable alternatives to the essay include creating a piece of art made from primarily recycled materials or a marketing/promotion campaign to be used and displayed by the Town.

<u>Repeat applicants</u> are required to give a brief update, 100 words or less, on their past year in college: successes, challenges, accomplishments, etc. (in lieu of the essay). Their responses may be posted on the Town website as part of our virtual "Wall of Fame" if they are successful scholarship recipients.

One or more applicants shall be chosen annually as the recipients of these scholarships, to be awarded in the amounts of \$500.00 and \$2,000.00 per year for as long as the funds are present. The one-year awards shall be given directly to the student based on proof of enrollment into a private or public post-secondary educational program. Applicants must supply follow-up receipts and an explanation of how the scholarship funds were spent to support their education.

The attached **Checklist for Applicants** will help guide the students to submit all the necessary information before the necessary deadline. Please forward this information to any citizens and past students who are interested. Personal Information Form:

Download the form, fill out the information, print and sign it.

□ Transcript:

Call the High School you have or will have graduated from to receive an official copy of your transcript. Unofficial copies are allowed, including computer print-offs from existing college students.

Financial Need Form:

Download the form, fill out the information, print and sign it. All information will be kept confidentially and should be based on the most recent US Income Tax Return. Please submit an additional statement for any extenuating circumstances that may affect your situation (e.g. other family members in college, change in job status, new career, etc.).

Applicant Appraisal or Counselor Report:

Download the form, fill out your name and give to your school counselor or a non-family member who is in a position of authority and knows you and your accomplishments. You may also email the form or link to your appraiser so they can fill it out on the computer.

The completed form must be submitted in a sealed envelope, signed by the Appraiser, and included in your application packet. The minimum amount is one completed appraisal form; however, you may submit up to three reports.

Essay, Art or Campaign:

First time applicants: submit an essay answering the question: "why is it important to protect the environment and what actions do you take in your daily life to reduce your environmental impact?" The essay should be 250-500 words.

Acceptable alternatives to the essay include creating a piece of art made my primarily recycled materials or a marketing/promotion campaign for recycling.

Repeat applicants: submit an update on your past year in college: successes, challenges, accomplishments, etc. The update should be 100 words or less.
