NOVEMBER 6, 2018**

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Kittery, in the County of York, qualified to vote, held on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018, the said inhabitants gave in their votes to elect three nominees for the Town Council for three years and two nominees for the School Committee for three-year terms. Answer the following two questions; a binding referendum to adopt the Comprehensive Plan Update 2015-2025 and a non-binding referendum to allow the town to have a limited number of non-medical sault-use marijuana retail stores in the town's commercial zones (C-1, C-2, C-3). The same were received, sorted, counted and declared in open meeting by the Warden who presided and in the presence of the Clerk, made a record thereof, as follows to wit:
