- IV. Chief O'Brien explained that State law allows campfires without permit, and Chief Richter mentioned some of the challenges of enforcement at Seapoint/Crescent: time to walk the beach, late at night with limited police staffing, etc.
- V. The committee discussed how to approach the issue and concluded that collecting information on how surrounding communities regulate, if at all, fires on public properties was the first step.
